Privacy Notice

This notice explains how we collect and use your personal information, who we share it with, and how we keep it secure. Records will be retained for a minimum of 6 years.

Where we store your personal information

We do not transfer your information to countries outside the European Economic Area (EEA).

Your rights

Under the GDPR, you have the right to access personal data held by us, the right to update personal data submitted to us, and the right to complain about our use of personal data. These rights do not apply in all circumstances, as we may hold your data on the basis of legal obligations.
